Message Title: FAITHFULNESS

Key Points

1. So far, we've looked at 7 of the 9 components of the Fruit of the Spirit. Today, Pastor Brian said that they all go together - they're interconnected.

Of the seven we've looked at so far (Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness and Faithfulness) which ones are more naturally a part of your life?

2. Faithfulness comes from the Greek word "Pistis" and it means fidelity, trustworthiness. Pastor Brian said that this basically boils down to:

You can count on me and I can count on God
