Key Points

1. **Have you ever heard someone use the phrase "I'm saved"?**

2. **Name a time when you sensed or felt the presence of God.**

Do you know when God is close to you?

3. **Read Act 4:12.**

Do you think your life and lifestyle - the way you act, treat others, talk, etc. - reflects a belief in Jesus?

4.	<p>Brian talked about belief actually changing the way you live your life.</p> <p>Does your faith alter your actions?</p> <p>If so, in what way(s)?</p>
5.	<p>Today's message taught us that Salvation is the absolute cleansing of sin, but not a license to continue to sin. Read Romans 6:1-4.</p> <p>How would you reconcile the idea that Jesus has cleansed you of your sin but you (and all of us) continue to sin, at least some times in some ways?</p>
6.	<p>Since Salvation is only found in Jesus, the real question is: have you committed your life to Him?</p> <p>Why or why not?</p> <p>If you have not committed your life to Him, we encourage you to reach out to your campus pastor or small group leader with any questions. Salvation is the most important decision you'll ever face in your life, so we hope that you'll continue to ask questions until you reach the point of a final decision.</p>

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
