**Message Title: Be Eager To Do Good**

Key Points	
<b>1.</b>	<b>Read Hebrews 10:22-25.</b> What are the three "let us" statements in these verses? How can we apply those? How can we encourage others to do good?
<b>2.</b>	In the book of James, Jesus's brother writes "So whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, for him it is sin." (James 4:17)  There are basically 2 categories of sins - the sin of commission (things we do wrong) and the sin of omission (things we should do, but don't). Which one do you struggle with the most?  How do you discern what the right thing is?
<b>3.</b>	Read Acts 9:36-43. What evidences from these verses points to the fact that Tabitha (also names Dorcas) was a believer or disciple?
<b>4.</b>	If someone were to examine our group, or our lives as individuals, what evidence would be found that we are believers or disciples?
<b>5.</b>	What other "works" do you see in these verses?
<b>6.</b>	At some point on some level, being devoted to doing good requires (implies) commitment. What is one way you can commit to Go and Do starting this week?
