



## **REEL Christmas Week 3 Small Group Guide**

### **KEY TEXTS**

Luke 2:17-19; Philippians 2:6-7

### **THE POINT**

Christmas means that even though the decorations come down and routines go back to normal, we should never stop proclaiming what God has done through Christmas, or pondering and treasuring what he has done for us.

### **LEADER NOTES**

We want to help students understand that just because the Christmas season does end, the impact that Jesus has on all of our lives never ends.

### **Ask the Following Questions:**

1. What's the greatest Christmas movie of all time? Why?
2. What is your all-time favorite Christmas memory?
3. What's something that stood out to you during tonight's talk?

### **Have a student read Luke 2:17-19.**

4. Why did the Shepherds feel the need to "spread the word" after they encountered Jesus?
5. What are some really practical ways we can "spread the word"?
6. What does it mean to "treasure and ponder" like Mary did verse 19?
7. What are some really practical ways we can "treasure and ponder" what Jesus did for us?
8. If you're a Christian, what is the best part about being a follower of Jesus
